Why should I do a graphical abstract?

A graphical abstract is an engaging way to bring in readers and help them decide to read your full paper. Graphical abstracts are shown to increase article views and related social media posts. They can also help spur popular press coverage. All of these things help increase your article's impact.

Where does the graphical abstract go?

They can appear on a journal's home page, tables of contents, abstract pages, and in social media.


How do I make one?

A graphical abstract can be completed using our simple template style and free programs like PiktoChart or Canva. They do not need to take a long time or cost money to create.


