Ambassador Invitations Update

15 new ambassadors had been confirmed for the program. Ambassador Training was held July 13 at 12:00 pm CT. The training was went well, and the few who could not attend watched a recording of Dr. Buscemi's presentation. Dr. Buscemi noted that the ambassadors would be engaged through position statements released by the Health Policy Committee.

Sign-ons and Endorsements

SBM had signed on to many statements since the council last met. Many of the following opportunities to sign-on and endorse were due to working with CSPI:

- CSPI <u>Supply Chains for the Production of Agricultural Commodities and Food Product</u>
- CSPI Child Nutrition Reauthorization (CNR) priorities
- Sen. Elizabeth Warren reintroducing the <u>Comprehensive Addiction</u> <u>Resources Emergency Act</u>
- Trust for America's Health <u>letter</u> to congressional leadership urging them to include Sen. Murray's <u>Public Health Infrastructure Saves Lives Act</u> (PHISLA, S. 674) in any infrastructure legislation being developed
- CSPI letter in support of the American Families Plan



New Coalitions in our Key Policy Areas & Training Opportunities for Ambassadors

Dr. Buscemi, Dr. Janke, and SBM staff had met to determine if the society should join additional coalitions. During this call, it was determined to join the coalitions and allow the ambassadors to attend the training opportunities available to them. The council decided that there would be a lead ambassador from each group who would engage the others and join the coalitions.
